Sam Williams writes:

'What is church'?

My 'thought for the week' has actually been my 'thought of the year' with my last 12 months prayers and thoughts mainly dedicated to the question, *What is Church?* I would also (as the youth worker) like to write about the youth work in our church however I feel that demographic has featured heavily in my thoughts of 'Church'."

"For where two or three gather in my name, there am I with them." Mathew 18:20 to me is the definition of Church, how do we see Church though? I admit that for most of my childhood Church was a place that adults went to sing songs and I would just count down the songs till youth group started (The average was 5). I now however see more and more of those times that I'm with my friends socialising, in youth

group, at a conference, in house group... as church!

Ian however is not at most of these events though, or any other clergy for that matter, we often don't sing, take communion or listen to a sermon together... so is this Church? For me... Yes! As I begin to delve deeper into Mathew 18:20 I see a call to let God be more involved in my day to day life and for me to see church as organic and fluid and not just a building or denomination.

The sermon is often replaced with the revelations of the week in what God has been showing me or others, the worship is admiring out loud how we have seen God moving or us listening to the same worship album in the car! The pastoral care is letting one talk and pray into your life, whether in someone's house, pub or street corner.

What could church look like to the thousands of people living in Bicester? I see church for many young mothers in Bure Park looking like a place to have coffee and relax amongst friends. I see

church with young people as a place that allows them to highlight social and environmental issues and to be able to wrestle with God's grace vs the world's impossible standards on themselves.

I can see so many different avenues of 'church' and believe God is moving in many different directions, expanding and creating new forms of 'church' and not just buildings.

What does/could 'church' look like in your life? Is it a small gathering of colleagues praying and edifying each other at work or could it be sharing life with your neighbours in your lounge once a month?
