Rach Bowen writes:

Oscar Wilde famously said "I can resist anything but temptation". A saying I think we can all relate with!

We have just entered into the period of Lent – a time to remember Jesus being led by the Spirit into the desert, where he was tempted by the devil. You can read about this in *Luke chapter 4*. The passage begins by saying that after Jesus fasted for 40 days and nights, "*He was hungry.*" I love this – nothing like stating the obvious!

His first temptation is to use His God-given power and authority to turn some stones into bread to satisfy His hunger. However, Jesus recognises that God will provide and He needs to trust him. This made me think – where do I look for my satisfaction? Do I trust that God will provide?

The devil then shows Jesus all the kingdoms of the world and offers Him a shortcut to power and glory if He switches allegiance to Satan. Jesus quotes one of the 10 commandments in His reply "*It is written: 'Worship the Lord your God and serve him only.'*" The origins of the word "worship" are from "worth-ship" – it is all about what we give worth to, what we value.

As humans, we are created to worship. If we don't worship God, we end up worshipping other things – be it money, celebrities, power, possessions. Who (or what) is it that we give worth to? Who (or what) do we serve?

The third temptation is all about identity. The devil challenges Jesus to prove that He really is the Son of God. I was struck by the fact that this period in the desert comes just after Jesus was baptised and there is a voice from heaven "*You are my Son, whom I love; with you I am well pleased.*"

Jesus knows who He is and who His Father is. Even on the cross, Jesus is challenged by bystanders with the same temptation

If you are the king of the Jews, save yourself.” He resists right to the end continuing to obey and trust God. Where is my identity? Am I secure, knowing that “I am no longer a slave to fear – I am a child of God”?. As we journey through Lent together, I pray that we all might find our satisfaction in our trustworthy God,

learning what it means to worship Him in spirit and in truth, and being secure in the knowledge that we are loved unconditionally and extravagantly by our heavenly Father.
