Chris Shields writes:

I wonder if you were at the Sunday evening service where Nigel Crooks introduced us to Brother Lawrence and his 'Practice of the Presence of God'. I strongly advise you to listen to the pod cast for some wonderful and inspiring teaching on this subject.

In my endeavours to come into God's presence I try to follow the discipline of Morning Prayer which is part of the Daily offices from the Northumbria Community, part of which follows below.

One thing I have asked of the Lord, this is what I seek:

That I may dwell in the house of the Lord

All the days of my life;

To behold the beauty of the Lord And to seek Him in His temple.

Who is it that you seek? I seek the Lord my God.

Do you seek Him with all your heart?

Amen, Lord have mercy.

Do you seek Him with all your soul?

Amen, Lord have mercy.

Do you seek Him with all your mind?

Amen, Lord have mercy.

Do you seek Him with all your strength? Amen, Christ have mercy.

The challenge that I face is this, do I really mean what I say? Do I really seek the Lord with all my heart, soul, mind and strength? What does it mean to 'seek' the Lord our God, and how can we begin this exploration?

Jeremiah 29:12-14 says:

'Then you will call upon Me and go and pray to Me, and I will listen to you. You will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart. I will be found by you, says the Lord, and I will bring you back from your captivity'.

How can we refuse this wonderful invitation He offers us or follow the example of Jesus himself:

Matthew 14:23'......he went up on a mountainside by himself to pray. When evening came, he was there alone,....'

Like Jesus, we need to withdraw to seek God's face in stillness and quietness, allowing God into our lives in a way that is pleasing to Him. With strength in our hearts, souls and minds we can release ourselves to the wonder of God as we soak in His presence.

Brother Lawrence was able to live his life continually in God's presence and these were his final words:

'I am doing what I shall do in all eternity. I am blessing God, praising Him,

worshipping Him, and loving Him with all my heart. That is all our profession, brothers, to worship God, to love Him, without troubling ourselves with anything else'



May this also be our prayer.
