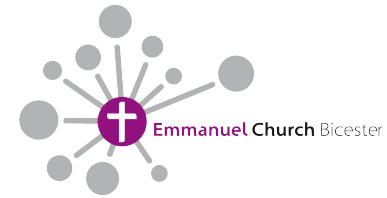

We will always fail if our understanding of ourselves is limited to the ways we can measure. But in God we can begin to understand the truth of who we are – to know him is to know ourselves.
