#### Ian Biscoe writes:

It is that time of year again when everything in the garden begins to burst into life. When things grow quickly and dramatically they create work! The cutting of grass is a task that often gets left in our garden. But if we do not cut and prune the garden it very quickly gets out of hand and looks a mess.

The same principal applies to Churches when they grow quickly and dramatically they create work! But what great work it is, trying to grow a church that makes disciples and loves and cares for people is hard work but the rewards far outweigh the costs. This does involve cutting and pruning sometimes but from there God produces fruit.

Jesus uses the imagery of his Father as a gardener in John 15;

'I am the true vine, and my Father is the gardener. <sup>2</sup> He cuts off every branch in me that bears no fruit, while every branch that does bear fruit he prunes so that it will be even more fruitful. <sup>3</sup> You are already clean because of the word I have spoken to you. <sup>4</sup> Remain in me, as I also remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in me.'

Have you ever noticed this passage begins with Jesus saying, 'He cuts off every branch in me that bears no fruit.' Is Jesus saying there are areas in His life that do not bear fruit? If so, then it would apply to every one of us. We all have areas in our lives that no longer bear fruit, they need to be cut off or pruned, so that new life can start to grow.

Last year I did some work in my garden that involved moving an entire hedge from one part of the garden to another. I was told a number of times that will never work, just leave it where it is. But now in this new season of Spring, the hedge is beginning to show signs of new life. It has been moved into a new position where it can do the job it was meant to do and continue to grow and flourish.

Are you where you are meant to be? What areas of your life need pruning or even cutting off? Jesus said, 'Remain in me, as I also remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine.'
