Just a moment perhaps ,but will we not hold on to it all week...?!

As we move towards the celebration of Easter Sunday I have to wonder if it was these very moments, that "bi-locationality" that Jesus walked perfectly in, (living in heaven and earth simultaneously) that empowered him to carry the cross up that hill, that allowed us to crucify him?
